About this property

4 Castle Walk is a handsome double-fronted detached house of the 1920s, in mellow red brick with stone detailing beneath a slate roof, set behind a low brick wall and a mature front garden on one of Wexbridge's most regarded streets. White-framed bay windows flank the front door, and the house retains its period fireplaces, oak floorboards and an easy, light-filled symmetry throughout.

The decoration is a calm palette of sage and cream. A traditional cream shaker kitchen sits to the rear with a dining room beside it opening to the garden; the sitting room and drawing room each centre on a period fireplace. To the first floor are four bedrooms, the principal with a re-fitted en suite shower room, served by a family bathroom with a roll-top bath.

Outside, the garden is laid mainly to lawn with established borders, a paved terrace and a brick store, and the gravel driveway provides parking for two cars behind the front wall. Castle Walk lies a short, level walk from Market Square, the parish church and Wexbridge's weekly market.
