

Cookie Policy

Introduction

This Cookie Policy outlines what cookies are and how we use them. You should read this policy so you can understand what type of cookies we use, the information collected by them and how we use this information.

Cookies do not typically contain any personal information that personally identifies you as a user. We may use information obtained through cookies to link information to you.

We do not store any personal information such as email addresses or passwords in the cookies we use.

Definitions

"Company" is OLXR LIMITED, that is registered in the Isle of Man under company registration number 133388C and is responsible for this policy (collectively referred to as ["the company", "we", "us" or "our" in this policy).

"Cookie" is defined as a small file placed on your computer, mobile device or other device by a website, typically containing some form of detail about your browsing history on that website.

"You" means the individual accessing or using the web application or any legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the web application.

Use of Cookies

Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies. Persistent cookies remain on your compute or mobile device when you leave the website or go offline, while session cookies are deleted as soon as you close your browser.

We use both persistent and session cookies for the purposes set out below:

	Type	Administered By	Purpose
Necessary / Essential cookies	Session Cookies	Us	These cookies are essential to providing you with the services available through the web application. For example, we use cookies to authenticate the user and stop fraudulent use of our web application.

Cookies Policy / Notice Acceptance Cookies	Persistent Cookies	Us	These cookies allow us to remember your choices on any notices. For example, accepting the cookie policy.
Functionality Cookies	Persistent Cookies	Us	These cookies allow us to remember your choices when personalising your experience. For example, when changing theme on the web application.
Tracking and Performance Cookies	Persistent Cookies	Third-Parties	These cookies are used to track information about traffic to the website and how users interact with our web application for us to improve and develop the product further and provide more relevant personalised content.

Your choices regarding Cookies

If you would prefer to avoid the use of cookies on our web application, you must disable the use of cookies within your browser and delete the cookies associated with our web application. You may use this option to prevent our web application storing cookies on your device at any time.

If you do not accept our cookies, you may experience some inconvenience in the use of our web application and some features may not work as expected.
